Dear Daffy Duck

Your application for a divorce has been checked by court staff and accepted. A copy of your application is included with this letter.

You have also been sent an email, confirming. You can track your divorce from the email.

What happens next

Your husband has been notified and sent the divorce application. They need to read the application and respond by 24 March 2022. You do not need to do anything.

You will receive a notification when they have responded. If they do not respond then you will be told what you can do next to progress the application.

The next step in the divorce process is to apply for a 'conditional order'. You have to wait until 27 July 2022 until you can apply. You will receive a notification with details of how you can apply.

Track your divorce

You can track the progress of your divorce from any email you have received from the divorce service.

Dividing your money and property

It's usually more straightforward and less expensive if you agree with your husband or wife on how to divide your money and property.

If you do agree then you can make the agreement legally binding. This is known as asking the court to make a 'consent order'.

If you disagree then you can ask the court to decide for you. This is known as applying for a 'financial order'.

You must tell the court if you've been married to more than one person during this marriage.
