Your husband Daffy Duck has applied for a divorce. A copy of their application is included with this letter. You need to respond to their application by 24 March 2022.

What you need to do

You need to respond to the divorce application by 24 March 2022. You have been sent details of how to respond to the email that your husband provided for you.

1. Create an online divorce account: <https://nfdiv-apply-fordivorce.aat.platform.hmcts.net/respondent>
2. Enter your reference number: 1646-7549-0007-3107
3. Enter your access code: PL36H8VB
4. Review and respond to their application

If it's past the date you should have responded 24 March 2022 then you can still try and respond online using the instructions above. The online service will tell you what you can do.

If you cannot get online, then contact the court using the details below and request a paper response form. If you do not respond then your husband can ask the court to progress the divorce application without you. You may have to pay extra fees if this happens.

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You must only respond to this divorce application if you are Donald Duck. You could be fined or imprisoned for contempt of court if you access this service illegally.

You must tell the court if you've been married to more than one person during this marriage.
